## To whom it may concern:

We are writing to express our sincere and heartfelt support for Elizabeth Linahon as an early childhood teacher and caregiver. Elizabeth, or Ms. Liz as she is known to my family, was our son August's preschool teacher for two years at Laurance Armour Day School (LADS). Preschool was August's first away from home care experience and we were anxious about his transition. Choosing child-care is a difficult and emotional process for parents — often one of the first crucial decisions they'll make for their child. We approached the task with some trepidation: would we make the right decision; would August be happy and safe; in addition to learning his A, B, C's would he get hugged regularly, talked to, read to, played with? Our experience with Ms. Liz was fantastic from the very beginning.

On the first day of school August said goodbye to us as if he was an old hat at this school thing. The next day he realized that school would be a recurring experience and he was very sad when I dropped him off. He did not want me to leave and I had to hold and comfort him. Ms. Liz effortlessly approached us and gently took August away from me and into her arms and soothed him. This went on for at least a week but Ms. Liz's gentle, calm and authoritative manner soon made August feel like part of the classroom and when I arrived to pick him up at the end of a long day, he did not want to go home!

Ms. Liz helped to create a safe, cozy and comfortable environment for the children to develop and learn in. The children respected her, and she in turn nurtured them and encouraged their growth and development. She was direct in addressing any issues that might arise in a child's care and she was always approachable; two qualities that we greatly appreciate as busy parents.

Our best assessment of the care Ms. Liz provided is our son August; a silly and affectionate five year old.

August had speech articulation issues that were of great concern to us as he was preparing for kindergarten. Ms. Liz's patience and encouragement contributed greatly to bolstering August's confidence in expressing himself and being well prepared for his next school. I asked August to describe Ms. Liz and what he liked about her. In typically direct five year old fashion he responded with, "I like her because she is nice and she read to us and she patted my back at nap time." That affirmed our impression of Ms. Liz as a kind educator who responded to the needs of the individual child.

We strongly attest to the high quality of Ms. Liz's character as a person and child care professional.
